Research and Scholarships Committee

Composition

- Committee Chair should be a Board member; a Co-Chair may be selected by the Committee Chair for approval by the President
- Up to 6 volunteers, to include SVU Foundation Treasurer and at least one physician. Additional members to be selected by the Chair; potential Board members are encouraged
- Some Committee members should have a working knowledge of research principles and processes

Purpose

The Research and Scholarships Committee oversees the Foundation's Research Grants, Ann Jones Scholarship, Annual Conference Grant, and Melissa Vickery Opportunity Grant programs.

Authority

Make recommendations regarding the criteria of the research grants and scholarships to the Foundation Board of Directors; Select recipients for annual grant and scholarship awards. Oversees Corporate Development Subcommittee.

Charge

The Research and Scholarships Committee oversees the Foundation's existing research and scholarship programs including possible program expansion or development in the following ways:

- Evaluates selection criteria for the research and scholarship programs and recommends revisions to criteria as appropriate
- Creates objective scoring system for Research Grant selection
- Develop an annual calendar for the Committee's activities, including critical dates, milestones, and required Board actions
- Develops strategies to increase technologist applications for research grants
- Develops strategies to increase applications for all scholarship awards
- Oversees the activities of the Corporate Development Subcommittee

Expectations

- Attend and participate in regular Research and Scholarship Committee meetings
- Contribute financially to the SVU Foundation at a level meaningful to the individual
- Come prepared to participate and engage

Accountability

- Committee provides status reports to the SVU Foundation Board of Directors during Board meetings.

Meeting Frequency

The Research and Grants Committee meets at least bi-monthly and as needed.
